Authorities ID 32-year-old man killed in Warren County crash

CUMMING, Iowa — Authorities have identified a man killed in an early-morning crash between a semitrailer and a car.

According to an Iowa State Patrol crash report, the crash happened at around 3 a.m. Wednesday in the southbound lanes of Interstate 35 near the Cumming exit just south of the metro.

“There was a passenger vehicle that was northbound in the southbound lane that struck a semi head-on,” Sgt. Kevin Stallo, with the Iowa State Patrol, told KCCI.

Thirty-two-year-old Wayne Christopher Field of Winterset died in the crash. Officials said he was not wearing a seat belt when the crash occurred.

A detour was in place, taking southbound traffic over the exit near the crash scene. Troopers said the cold, early-morning conditions played a major role in the long cleanup process.
